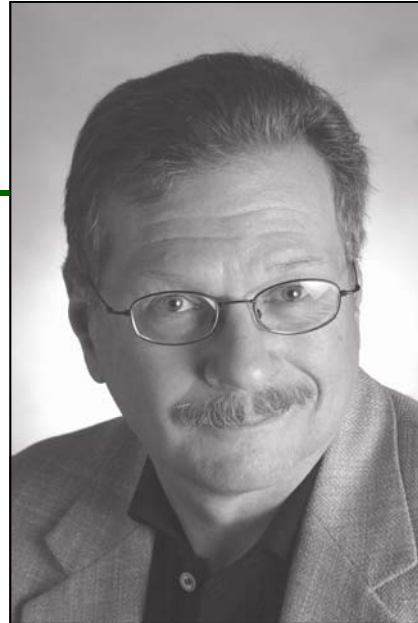


Introducing Steven Levi

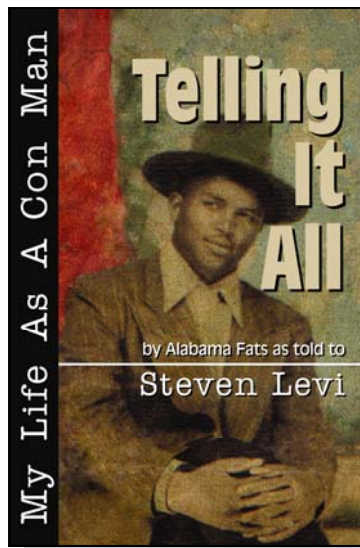
