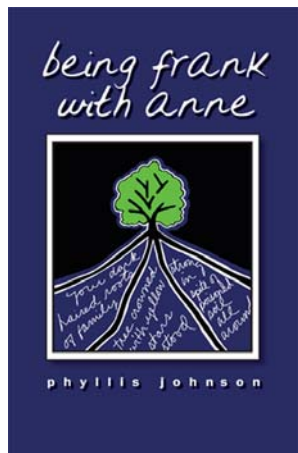


being frank with anne
